

THE TRILLION-DOLLAR QUESTION GAME

A nail-biting game of integrity intrigue for 2 – 3 small teams

GOAL

Address water integrity scenarios and be the first to get to the finish line of successful project completion!

OUTLINE

Take turns to roll the die and move around the board, addressing risk/challenge cards across four stages of programme management:

- Project and budget planning – **TURQUOISE**
- Design and procurement processes – **PINK**
- Project and budget implementation – **BLUE**
- Project and budget M&E and audit – **GREEN**

Go with a tried-and-tested tool or example, and move forward three spaces. Go with your own solution, and, as in real-life, accept the risk of the unknown for the chance find a more effective approach – roll the die to see how far you progress!

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Get into pairs or small teams and choose a game piece, and place it in the starting square.
2. Each team rolls the die to decide who goes first – highest number begins.
3. Roll the die and move that number of spaces.
4. Pick up a risk card that matches your phase/colour. Read the risk aloud to the group.
5. Work quickly within your pair or small group to come up with a solution. Propose it to the group.
6. Flip the card to see the good practice solution. Read the good practice solution aloud to the group.
7. DECIDE:
 - a. Go with the tested tool or example solution and **move three spaces**.
 - b. Go with your own solution, accept the risk of the unknown, and roll the die to **see how many spaces you move**.
8. Move that number of spaces.
9. Next team goes. Continue to take turns.
10. Play until a team gets to the finish square (either by landing on it, or moving past it), or until you run out of time. For the latter, the team furthest along is winner.
